Legal aid: fears for children

Children could be put in danger by the Government's plans to cut legal aid, a coalition of charities and other pressure groups warns in a letter published in *The Daily Telegraph* today.

The letter, signed by 27 groups, said measures such as a UK "residency test" to qualify for state-funded legal assistance could put children's "safety and well-being at risk".

"We are deeply shocked by the range of proposed restrictions on legal aid and the absence of any consideration of how these changes would affect children," says the letter.
